Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is purely academic. Both the Parties are intending to specify:

- Customize course curriculums and training as per the requirements of the industry.
- Carrying out different R & D activities
- Carrying out different Awareness programmes, seminars and symposium, workshops, specialized training.
- Exchange of resource persons.

- Internship opportunities for the students in live project.
- Carrying out Internship Programme for the students of the College.
- Implementation of different CSR and or Socio economic and environmental Projects.
- Exchange of ideas and data that are required for conducting any research projects.
- Target towards collaborative and joint works on setting up enabling environment to spread Education and Skill development & R & D know how, expertise best practices in the areas of R & D, Higher education, Skills Training, Train the Trainer programs, Assessment, training of Assessors, conduct Skill Gap analysis, provide specific knowhow on skills training and technology, prior learning recognition, create assessment and certification programs.

Role of the Rani Birla Girls' College, Kolkata

- Dr. Chalantika Laha Salui, Assistant Professor, Department of Geography, Nodal Officer for Internship Programmes and Mr. Debarshi Bhattacharyya, Faculty Department of Journalism & Mass Communication, MoU Coordinator, Rani Birla Girls' College will coordinate on behalf of the Rani Birla Girls' College.
- Rani Birla Girls' College will jointly work with IIARI to promote capacity building, workshop, environmental awareness and gender sensitization programmes and other such activities.
- Rani Birla Girls' College will facilitate joint research activities involving students and teachers.
- Rani Birla Girls' College will be authorized to carry its name and logo of IIARI in its reports/any publicity materials etc. that carries joint / mutual interest only as 'COLLABORATOR'.

Role of the IIARI:

- IIARI will help Rani Birla Girls' College in organizing value added Courses/Certificate courses / Add-on Courses as per the need of the college by providing required resource persons.
- IIARI will facilitate student and faculty exchange programmes.
- IIARI will provide internship opportunities for the students of Rani Birla Girls' College and facilitate joint research activities involving students and teachers.
- IIARI will assist Rani Birla Girls' College in organizing environmental awareness and gender sensitization programmes.
- IIARI will carry name and logo of Rani Birla Girls' College in its reports/any publicity materials etc. that carries joint / mutual interest only as 'COLLABORATOR'.

Financial Liabilities

There will be no financial burden on both the parties. In case of student and faculty exchange programmes the cost will be carried by respective participants. In case if both the parties are jointly carrying out a joint project the financial terms will be decided by both the parties based on the cost of the project. IIARI will provide 25% of a course fees to the college if there will be any joint certification programme or diploma programme,

Period and Applicability

Unless terminated earlier as per the provision herein contained, this agreement shall be valid for an initial period of 5 (Five) years from the date of signing this MOU. Subsequently, this agreement may be renewed for such further term or terms as may be mutually agreed upon.

Termination

This agreement is valid till terminated by either party under mutual understanding. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by giving 90 (NINETY) days written notice. Projects, which may be undergoing and/or have been undertaken, should be completed before termination of the agreement.

Governing Law and Disputes

The laws of India shall govern this agreement and any & all obligations arising out of or connected to it. Each Party submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Kolkata. Any disputes with respect to any matter or
