- 4. Resource Sharing: Both parties agree to share resources, including expertise, facilities, and networks, to support the objectives of this collaboration. - 5. Termination of the agreement specified in this MoU is automatic upon the fulfillment of the agreed-upon five-year period. Alternatively, BOTH PARTIES may initiate termination prior to the completion of the agreed period by providing written notices. The MoU is open to extension based on the mutual consent of BOTH PARTIES, if such an extension is deemed necessary in the future.
