Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

#### II. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

- The CLIENT will collect all the Dry Recyclables and other waste from the main storage location.
- (ii) The representative of **The CLIENT** shall intimate to Vital Waste to collect Recyclables and other waste.
- (iii) After expiry of first 1 (one) month from the date of first collection, Vital Waste will decide the collection frequency of future collections with mutual discussion with The CLIENT.
- (iv) After finalization of the collection frequency, Collection Staff of Vital Waste will call the **The CLIENT** and check the collection requirement of Recyclables and other waste.
- (v) Collection Staff of Vital Waste will collect the Recyclables and other waste from the premises of **The CLIENT** after getting the collection requirement from the office of **The CLIENT** on next day or within 3 working days from the receipt of collection request from the office of **The CLIENT**.
- (vi) Collection Staff of Vital Waste will be equipped with the weighing machines to perform the measurement of Recyclables and other waste in the presence of authorized representative of The CLIENT in presence of the authorized representative and/or staffs of the vital Waste/Second part herein and record the weight of the waste with signature putting therein.
- (vii) Collection summary will be given to The CLIENT in writing upon collection either in physical or electronic form.
- (viii) 2 seminars in the college and 1 industrial visit to 5 students and 1 teacher.

We are having this MOU for the tenure from 01/01/2023 to 31/12/2023.

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#### ARTICLE-4

#### EARNINGS, INVOICING AND PAYMENTS

- (i) All Recyclables and other waste so collected from The CLIENT shall be divided into various Categories in accordance with the 'Pricing Annexure' as is provided in ANNEXURE 1.
- (ii) Vital Waste shall determine category-wise quantity of Recyclables collected from The CLIENT. Such figures of the quantity of each category of Recyclables so collected from The CLIENT shall be represented in the collection summary.
- (iii) For Recyclables and Waste Collected having positive value as per ANNEXURE 1:
  - a. The CLIENT shall issue a sales invoice for such material to Vital Waste with the applicable rate of taxes, if the CLIENT is registered under GST; or

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
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



Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

Purpose of the Agreement



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 19/08/23, between Women's Christian College and Rani Birla Girls' College for mutual cooperation witnesseth in academic exchanges, program development and research. This document establishes the guiding terms and principles of collaboration between the two organizations:

### I. Legal Frameworks of Both the Organizations

Women's Christian College, affiliated under the University of Calcutta and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its Principal Prof. (Dr.) Ajanta Paul hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns)

Rani Birla Girls' College, affiliated under the University of Calcutta and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its Principal Prof. (Dr.) Srabanti Bhattacharya hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns). Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

### II. Purpose of the Agreement

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions through following but not limited to:

1. Joint teaching and research projects.

- 2. Collaboration in the area of academic publications, research activities, field trips etc.
- 3. Visit, training and exchange of faculty, staff and students
- 4. Joint educational/vocational courses.
- 5. Joint consultancy, PhD. supervision, scientific publications.
- 6. Co-hosting and participation in conferences, seminars, symposiums and workshops.
- 7. Social and cultural programs
- 8. Any other activity that is mutually agreed upon and is beneficial to both.

III. Execution of the Agreement

The specific activities to be carried out under this agreement will be stated in corresponding specific sub-agreements. Such specific sub-agreements, once approved by both parties, will be attached as annexes to this agreement.

The specific sub-agreements between both Parties will specify their objectives, conditions and ways of execution, financial support, period the sub-agreement will be in effect, and administrative responsibility within each institution.

Term and Expiration of the Agreement

It is understood that this agreement will come into effect after being signed by both Parties and will be established for a period of five years. After these five yearsit will be automatically extended for same period, unless one of the Parties expresses an intention (by written notification) to cancel the agreement at least 90 days before the expiry date. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the Parties.

any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both Parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to

these representatives.



## NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.

#### SPECIAL PROVISIONS VI.

1. Each party will take approval from the other party in writing prior to using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.

2. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient

implementation of the programs.

3. The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.

4. Neither party can misuse this MoU by involving the name of the other without the

written consent from the other party.

5. There will be no financial involvement by neither of the party.

#### VII. DISPUTES

If any dispute arises in respect of the MoU, in that case both the organisations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.
